IT IS FURTHER ORDERED herein that all summonses having been served with a return date of January 31, 2019 shall become returnable on the next court date,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time for the filing of all other documents required to be filed on or before said date of January 31, 2019 be and the same hereby is extended to the next court date,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all matters set for hearing on January 30, 2019 shall be and the same hereby are continued to February 28, 2019, or to such further date as may be agreed upon by the parties or upon a new notice for hearing served therein.
