GENERAL ORDER 19-16**

**WHEREAS**, the Kane County State's Attorney's Office has created a voluntary Prostitution/Solicitation Deferred Prosecution Program for an offender charged for the first time with an act of prostitution or solicitation; and

**WHEREAS**, offenders admitted into the Prostitution/Solicitation Deferred Prosecution Program by the Kane County State's Attorney's Office agree to complete all requirements of said Program; and

**WHEREAS**, requirements of the Prostitution/Solicitation Deferred Prosecution Program include, but are not limited to, payment of the following fees, fines and costs to be collected by the Kane County Circuit Clerk of the Court:

Application Fee of \$50  
Circuit Clerk fees as provided by statute and/or resolution  
Drug Testing Administrative Fee of \$25  
Program Fee not to exceed \$1,000



**WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

The Clerk of the Circuit Court shall collect and distribute the required fees, fines and costs of the Prostitution/Solicitation Deferred Prosecution Program as follows:

1. That the \$50.00 Application Fee shall be deposited into and kept in a fund marked for the use of the Kane County State's Attorney's Office for purposes of administering the Prostitution/Solicitation Deferred Prosecution Program, account Number 001.300.000.35355;
2. That the \$25.00 Drug Testing Administrative Fee shall be deposited into and kept in a fund marked for the use of the Kane County State's Attorney's Office for the purposes of administering the Prostitution/Solicitation Deferred Prosecution Program, account Number 001.300.000.35270;
3. That the Kane County State's Attorney, taking into account the defendant's ability to pay the Program Fee, retains the authority to impose said fee, not to exceed \$1,000, which shall be deposited into and kept in a fund marked for the use of the Kane County State's Attorney's Office for the purposes of administering the Prostitution/Solicitation Deferred Prosecution Program, account Number 001.300.000.35355.
4. That the Circuit Clerk fees shall be distributed as provided by statute and/or resolution.
5. This Order amends, supplements, and where inconsistent supersedes General Order 14-19.
