**WHEREAS**, the Kane County State's Attorney's Office has created a voluntary Felony Drug Deferred Prosecution Program for offenders charged for the first time with Unlawful Possession of Controlled Substance, a Class 4 felony, and Unlawful Possession of Cannabis a Class 4 felony; and

**WHEREAS**, offenders admitted into the Felony Drug Deferred Prosecution Program by the Kane County State's Attorney's Office agree to complete all requirements of said Program; and

**WHEREAS**, requirements of the Felony Drug Deferred Prosecution Program include, but are not limited to, payment of the following fees, fines and costs to be collected by the Kane County Circuit Clerk of the Court:

- Application Fee of \$50
- Circuit Clerk fees as provided by statute and/or resolution
- Drug Testing Administrative Fee of \$25
- Drug Fine of \$500
- Program Fee not to exceed \$1,500.

**WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

The Clerk of the Circuit Court shall collect and distribute the required fees, fines and costs of the Felony Drug Deferred Prosecution as follows:

1. The \$50 Application Fee shall be deposited into and kept in a fund marked for the use of the Kane County State's Attorney's Office for purposes of administering the Felony Drug Deferred Prosecution Program, account Number 001.300.000.35280;

2. The \$25.00 Drug Testing Administrative Fee shall be deposited into and kept in a fund marked for the use of the Kane County State's Attorney's Office for the purposes of administering the Felony Drug Deferred Prosecution Program, account Number 001.300.000.35270;


3. The \$500 Drug Fine shall be distributed by the Circuit Clerk pursuant to the provisions of the Drug Fine Distribution Order entered by the Judge presiding over the case.

4. The Kane County State's Attorney, taking into account the defendant's ability to pay the Program Fee, retains the authority to impose said fee, not to exceed \$1,500, which shall be deposited into and kept in a fund marked for the use of the Kane County State's Attorney's Office for the purposes of administering the Felony Drug Deferred Prosecution Program, account Number 001.300.000.35280;

5. The Circuit Clerk fees shall be distributed as provided by statute and/or resolution.

6. This general order amends and supersedes General Orders 12-12 and 14-21.
