WHEREAS, in the interest of providing support for defendants to comply with court-ordered sentencing in DUI cases and facilitate the opportunity for defendants to avoid the requirement of returning to court at a future date;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**: Kane County Court Services shall operate the Court Sentence Monitoring Program as follows:

- 1. The Presiding Judge in CR203 (DUI) may sentence individuals on non-reporting sentences to participate in the Court Sentence Monitoring Program.
- 2. A sentence to the Court Sentence Monitoring Program shall provide for a final return date and include that the defendant shall contact Court Services at 630-232-5805 within 48 hours of sentencing for a review of the program and the terms of their respective sentence with a Court Services Officer.
- 3. The Clerk of the Circuit Court shall send notice to Court Services of the defendant's entry into the Program.
- 4. If it is determined by Court Services that a defendant is in compliance with all of the terms of their sentence at least sixty (60) days prior to the final return date, Court Services shall file a Termination Report with the Clerk of the Circuit Court verifying that all terms have been completed.
- 5. Upon receipt of the filing of proof of the completion of all terms, and if no Petition to Revoke has been filed by the prosecuting agency, the Clerk of the Circuit Court is to discharge the defendant satisfactorily and strike any future court dates.
- 6. In the event that the individual has not completed said terms at least sixty (60) days prior to the final date, Court Services shall file with the Clerk of Circuit Court the Termination Report outlining all terms that remain outstanding, and the defendant must appear in court at their final return date.
