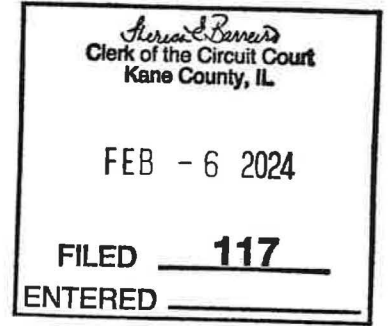

**WHEREAS**, subject to the overall authority of the Illinois Supreme Court and pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court Rule 21, the chief judge having authority to determine courtroom scheduling;

**THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that General Order 22-39 effective on December 4, 2023, is hereby amended as follows:

**FELONY DIVISION**

**Courtroom 217-** Specialty Court cases will continue to be heard in CR217.

All Violation of Probation (VOP) cases will be heard in their courtroom of origin, unless unavailable, and then to a courtroom designated by the Presiding Judge of the Felony Division.

VOP hearings will be added to court calls on Wednesdays and Fridays at 9:00am, or as otherwise indicated by the Presiding Judge of the Felony Division.
