TAX OBJECTION

REQUIREMENTS WHICH NEED TO BE MET BEFORE A TAX OBJECTION CAN BE FILED:

- 1. If a person desires to file a tax objection complaint, he or she shall pay all of the tax due within sixty (60) days from the first penalty date of the final (second) installment of taxes. (35 ILCS 200/23-5).
- 2. The complaint itself must be filed within 75 days from the first penalty date of the final (second) installment of taxes. (35 ILCS 200/23-10).
- 3. When both tax installments are paid in full and the tax objection complaint is filed with the Circuit Clerk, then the tax objection complaint is considered a protest of 100.00% of the taxes paid under protest.

 Please note that no protest form or letter of protest or any notation of protest on the tax bill is required

at the time of payment of your taxes.

- 4. In order to file a tax objection on the assessed valuation, you must first have filed an assessment complaint with the Kane County Board of Review at the appropriate time. If you did not file an assessment complaint with the Board of Review on the equalized valuation, it would be grounds for dismissal of your tax objection complaint.
- 5. The tax objection complaint itself names the *County Collector* as a defendant, but the collector does not have to file an answer or appearance or other pleading. No complaint may be filed as a class action. (35 ILCS 200/23-10).

A copy of the procedures for tax objections from the Illinois Statutes is attached.

If after reviewing this information, you wish to file a tax objection complaint, the following are some procedures which can be followed to help you accomplish this task:

PROCEDURES FOR FILING A TAX OBJECTION COMPLAINT:

- 1. New Case Information Sheet. This form is available to you through the Kane County Circuit Clerk's Office, Intake Division, 540 S. Randall Rd., St. Charles, IL 60174 or Kane County Courthouse, Rm 160, 100 S. 3rd St., Geneva, IL 60134, and needs to be filled out by you. The Case Type on the form should be filled in with 'TX' and the *Sub Case Type* should be filled in with '0408'. Number 4, *Jury*, should be filled in 'no'. The rest of the form should be self-explanatory.
- 2. <u>Tax Objection Complaint.</u> This is a two-page form which is available to you through the Kane County Circuit Clerk's Office, Civil Division, 540 S. Randall Rd., St. Charles, IL 60174 or Kane County Courthouse, Rm 160, 100 S. 3rd St., Geneva, IL 60134. This form needs to be filled out by you. On the first page you need to fill in the name and address of each taxing body which is affected by this objection. These names and addresses can be found on your real estate tax bill.
- 3. Once these two forms have been filled out, three (3) copies of the complaint need to be filed with the Kane County Circuit Clerk. The current filing fees can be found on the Circuit Clerk's website at: www.cic.co.kane.il.us under Fees. There is a filing fee for each tax objection regardless of the number of parcels involved or the number of tax payers joining on the complaint.
- 4. Within ten (10) days after the complaint is filed, the Clerk of the Circuit Court shall deliver one copy to the State's Attorney and one copy to the County Clerk.
- 5. The County Clerk shall, within 30 days from the last day of filing of objections, notify the duly elected or appointed custodian of funds for each taxing body that you named in your complaint, stating that an objection has been filed.
- 6. The State's Attorney's Office shall notify you, the taxing body custodian(s), and the County Clerk in writing of the date, time, and place of any hearing before the Court not less than four (4) days prior to hearing.
