Pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court Order M.R. 30370, as amended February 22, 2022, and the Court's inherent authority,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that commencing February 28, 2022:

- 1) Masks within the Kane County Courthouses are permitted, but not required.
- 2) Persons choosing to wear a mask may be directed by a judge to remove it if deemed necessary for court purposes, such as when addressing the court or testifying.
- 3) Individuals, including judges, court staff, parties, attorneys, jurors, and witnesses should not enter any courthouse if they:
  - a) Have new flu-like symptoms including fever, cough, or shortness of breath (excluding symptoms caused by chronic conditions);
  - b) Currently have been directed to quarantine or isolate at home by any medical provider or public health official; and
  - c) Reside or have regular close contact with a person currently subject to a quarantine or isolation direction issued by a medical provider or public health official and are not themselves fully vaccinated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court may issue further Orders, as necessary, to address the changing circumstances surrounding the Coronavirus pandemic.
