WHEREAS, the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit utilizes the Public Safety Assessment (PSA) tool for risk-assessments;

WHEREAS, Pretrial Services will complete the PSA, a regularly validated risk assessment tool, for all individuals held for their First Appearance;

WHEREAS, pursuant to 725 ILCS 5/110-6.4, which states in pertinent part:

“...If a risk-assessment tool is utilized within a circuit that does not require a personal interview to be completed, the Chief Judge of the circuit or the director of the pretrial services agency may exempt the requirement under Section 9 and subsection (a) of Section 7 of the Pretrial Services Act.”

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pretrial Services is exempt from the requirement of a personal interview of the defendant since the PSA does not require a personal interview to be completed.
