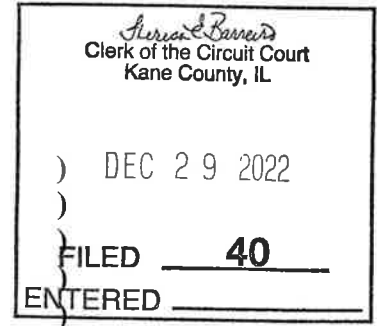

**IN THE MATTER OF**  
**COURTROOM 005 SCHEDULE**  
**AMENDING OR SUPERSEDING**  
**ALL PRIOR CONFLICTING**  
**GENERAL ORDERS PERTAINING TO COURTROOM 005**

**WHEREAS**, subject to the overall authority of the Illinois Supreme Court and pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court Rule 21, the chief judge having the authority to determine the times and places of holding court and the types of cases assigned thereto.

Defendants will be brought to the Kane County Judicial Center to speak with the Public Defender or private counsel.

9:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

Arrest warrants, initial summonses, search warrants, search warrant returns, Petitions for Authorization for Eavesdrops and returns

10:00 a.m.

Initial appearances begin for all criminal cases where defendants have not been released with a Citation and Notice to Appear or have been arrested on a Probable Cause warrant

1:30 p.m.

Hearings begin on Petitions to Deny Pretrial Release

**Weekends and Holidays**

**Saturdays**

7:00 a.m. – 7:30 a.m.

Defendants will be brought to the Kane County Judicial Center to speak with the Public Defender or private counsel.

10:00 a.m.

Initial appearances begin for all criminal cases where defendants have not been released with a Citation and Notice to Appear or have been arrested on a Probable Cause warrant or a Failure to Appear warrant

**Sundays and those days ordered by the Presiding Judge**

7:00 a.m. – 7:30 a.m.

Defendants will be brought to the Kane County Judicial Center to speak with the Public Defender or private counsel.

9:00 a.m.

Juvenile detention hearings

10:00 a.m.

Initial appearances begin

**Hearing Times – Petitions to Deny Pretrial Release**

Upon completion of initial appearances, hearings on Petitions to Deny Pretrial Release will begin as soon as practicable from the last initial appearance hearing.
