AMENDING GENERAL ORDER 20-10)

WHEREAS, in 2021, the Illinois General Assembly passed, and the Governor signed Public Act 101-0652 into law, which is commonly known as the Safety, Accountability, Fairness and Equity-Today Act (SAFE-T Act).

WHEREAS, said statutory framework for pretrial release had been separately introduced but then legislated through the SAFE-T Act, and is also considered as the Pretrial Fairness Act (PFA).

WHEREAS, the PFA had been stayed through the handling of litigation, which challenged its constitutionality, and this stay will end on September 18, 2023. *See Rowe v. Raoul*, 2023 IL 129248 ¶ 52 (July 18, 2023).

WHEREAS, General Order 20-10, In the Matter of Covid-19, Civil, Misdemeanor, and Traffic Warrants, Writs, and Notice to Appear, is no longer necessary and is hereby vacated instanter.
